<b>Goals/Purpose/Rationale of Study</b> (Provides a clear description of the specific goals/purpose of the program, including location and program outline, itinerary, or curriculum of the event or activity. Provides the reason/rationale for participating in the event/activity and describes how the new learning will be connected to or applied to current/future activities.)					
<b>Goals for Future TSO/DKG Involvement</b> (Identifies the specific offices and/or committees she plans to serve in and how she plans to "give back" to TSO in return for receiving the scholarship, such as volunteering to serve on the TSO Scholarship Committee in the near future, writing an article for the <i>Lone Star News</i> about how the scholarship enriched her life, sharing her new learning within schools, chapter, or community organizations, etc.)
